Re: Grade Five-Eight Drop-in Admission Pass Program

This letter is to request your assistance and support in the promotion of Delta's Grade 5-8 Drop-in Admission Pass Program. Delta Parks, Recreation & Culture has offered this program to Delta students since 2005 as a way to ***encourage healthy, active lifestyles and to introduce Delta's youth to our recreation facilities.***

The Drop-in Admission Pass allows all Grade 5-8 students who live in Delta to utilize Parks, Recreation & Culture drop-in programs from September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2019. This program has proven to be very successful over the years and has resulted in introducing many families to activities they may not otherwise have tried.

Delta is once again seeking your assistance to promote the program to your teachers and students. Students can activate their pass at any time, at any Delta recreation facility by providing proof of age and residency and paying a \$5.00 administrative fee.

Grade 5, 6, 7 and 8 Students

Beginning September 1, 2018 drop by any Delta recreation facility listed below and activate the Grade Five, Six, Seven and Eight Annual Drop-in Admission Pass. With the pass, you will be able to attend unlimited drop-in SKATE, SWIM or OPEN GYM sessions. And you can bring along a youth, young adult or adult, at a reduced family admission rate, each time you use your pass!



Eligibility Requirements

All Delta residents who were born in 2005-2008, or who are in grade five, six, seven or eight as of September 2018, are eligible for a pass with the payment of a \$5 administration fee.

In order to activate the Grade Five, Six, Seven and Eight pass, simply go to the Customer Service Office at any Delta recreation facility and present proof of birth date and Delta residence, along with the \$5 fee. Students who are older or younger than the typical grade five, six, seven or eight student will need a signed letter from their principal to confirm enrollment.
